

GOVERNMENT STATEMENT ON THE ENHANCED RAINS AND FLOODING

State House, Nairobi April 25, 2024

His Excellency the President has today chaired an emergency session of all the key stakeholders in the response to the ongoing flooding across the country. The meeting has resolved as follows:

Established a Multi-Agency Emergency Response Centre domiciled in the Ministry of Interior.

All internally displaced persons will be facilitated to find alternative settlement. In extreme cases, the National Youth Service will provide shelter to the most vulnerable members of our society.

The affected households will be provided with food and non-food items.

I will tomorrow chair the Committee on National Disaster Response incorporating all stakeholders including development partners.

The outlook for the next week indicates that the country will receive above normal rainfall across the country. In that regard, all members of the public are urged to exercise caution while traveling and those living in the low lands to move to higher grounds.
